## MANIFESTING ITS RICHNESS. SALCEDA'S COMMITMENT

Viña Salceda is located by the Ebro River in Elciego, one of the most iconic villages in Rioja Alavesa. With a winemaking legacy of over 50 years, the winery is now entering a new and exciting phase under the guidance of renowned oenologist David González. This new chapter embraces a renewed focus on terroir, crafting contemporary wines that reflect the richness and diversity of Rioja's most exceptional subzones.

Our nearly 250 acres of vineyards of sustainable viticulture are spread across distinctive areas, particularly Sonsierra and Alto Najerilla, in the southwest of Rioja. These regions offer a remarkable mix of soil types, altitudes, climates, and grape varieties.

The vineyard's elevations range from 1700FT to 2300 feet above sea level, with vines over 110 years old. The continental climate contributes to wines with outstanding freshness and vibrant acidity. Viña Salceda is proud to blend the depth of Rioja's winemaking history.

## Viña Salceda La Rellanilla 2023



### **HISTORY:**

Viña Salceda, founded in Elciego by the Ebro River, combines over 150 years of tradition with a modern vision. The winery honors its rich heritage while producing elegant, enduring wines that respect the landscape and history of Rioja Alavesa.

### **TECHNICAL TASTE:**

**Region/ Sub-Region:** Spain, D.O.C. Rioja

**Alcohol:** 14.5%

**Variety:** 100% Tempranillo Grapes

**Aging:** 6 months in concrete tanks with fine lees

**Tasting Notes:** A rich, deep-colored wine with a hint of purple at the edge. On the nose, it's vibrant with aromas of blackberries, blueberries, and a touch of earthiness that reminds you of chalk. There's also a floral note of violets and a hint of licorice spice. In the mouth, it's smooth and silky, with a nice fullness and soft tannins. The acidity is just right, bringing a great balance to the wine.

**Tim Atkin July 2025:** Awarded 92 points to La Rellanilla 2023. La Rellanilla is a very promising new wine from David González that comes from young vines in the parcel of the same name in one of the cooler parts of Laguardia. Lees-aged in concrete, it's all about fruit rather than oak, with plenty of chalky minerality, vibrant black cherry and wild strawberry flavours and lots of zip and energy.

**Peñín August 2025** Awarded 91 points to La Rellanilla 2023.
