Viña Salceda is located by the Ebro River in Elciego, one of the most iconic villages in Rioja Alavesa. With a winemaking legacy of over 50 years, the winery is now entering a new and exciting phase under the guidance of renowned oenologist David González. This new chapter embraces a renewed focus on terroir, crafting contemporary wines that reflect the richness and diversity of Rioja's most exceptional subzones.

Our nearly 250 acres of vineyards of sustainable viticulture are spread across distinctive areas, particularly Sonsierra and Alto Najerilla, in the southwest of Rioja. These regions offer a remarkable mix of soil types, altitudes, climates, and grape varieties.

The vineyard's elevations range from 1700FT to 2300 feet above sea level, with vines over 110 years old. The continental climate contributes to wines with outstanding freshness and vibrant acidity. Viña Salceda is proud to blend the depth of Rioja's winemaking history.

HISTORY:

Viña Salceda, founded in Elciego by the Ebro River, combines over 150 years of tradition with a modern vision. The winery honors its rich heritage while producing elegant, enduring wines that respect the landscape and history of Rioja Alavesa.

TECHNICAL TASTE:

Region/ Sub-Region: Spain, D.O.C. Rioja

Alcohol: 13.5%

Variety: 95% Tempranillo Grapes, 4% Graciano Grapes, 1% Mazuelo Graoes

Aging: Aged for 18 months in French and American oak Bordeaux barrels, plus another 12 months in the bottle.

Tasting Notes: Medium cherry in color, bright and elegant. The nose is expressive, offering aromas of fresh stone fruits like cherries and plums that is beautifully interwoven with subtle spice and a creamy undertone. On the palate, it reveals intensity and complexity, with remarkably smooth, well-integrated tannins. Long, savory, and enveloping, this wine shows impressive structure and finesse, with outstanding potential for further aging.
